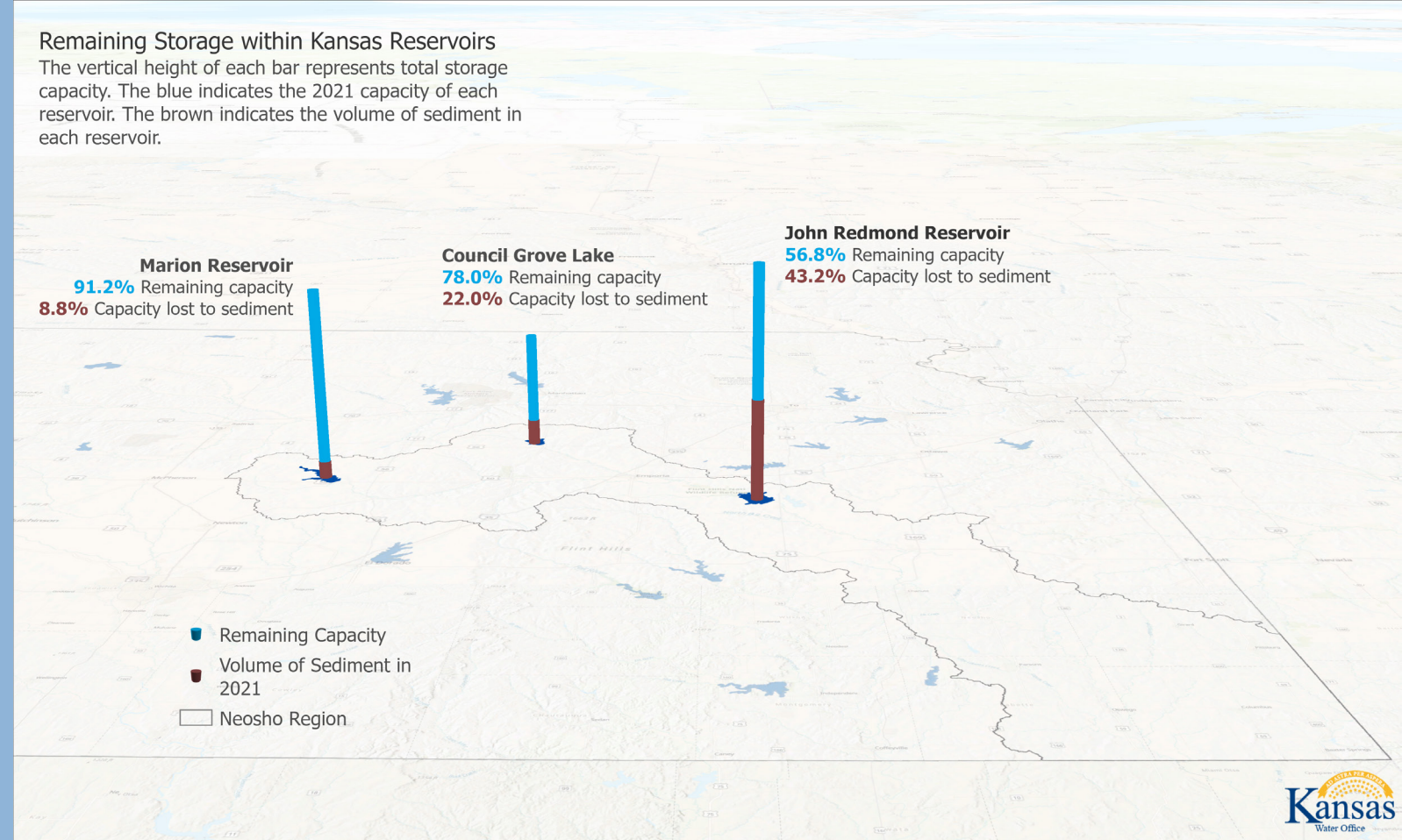
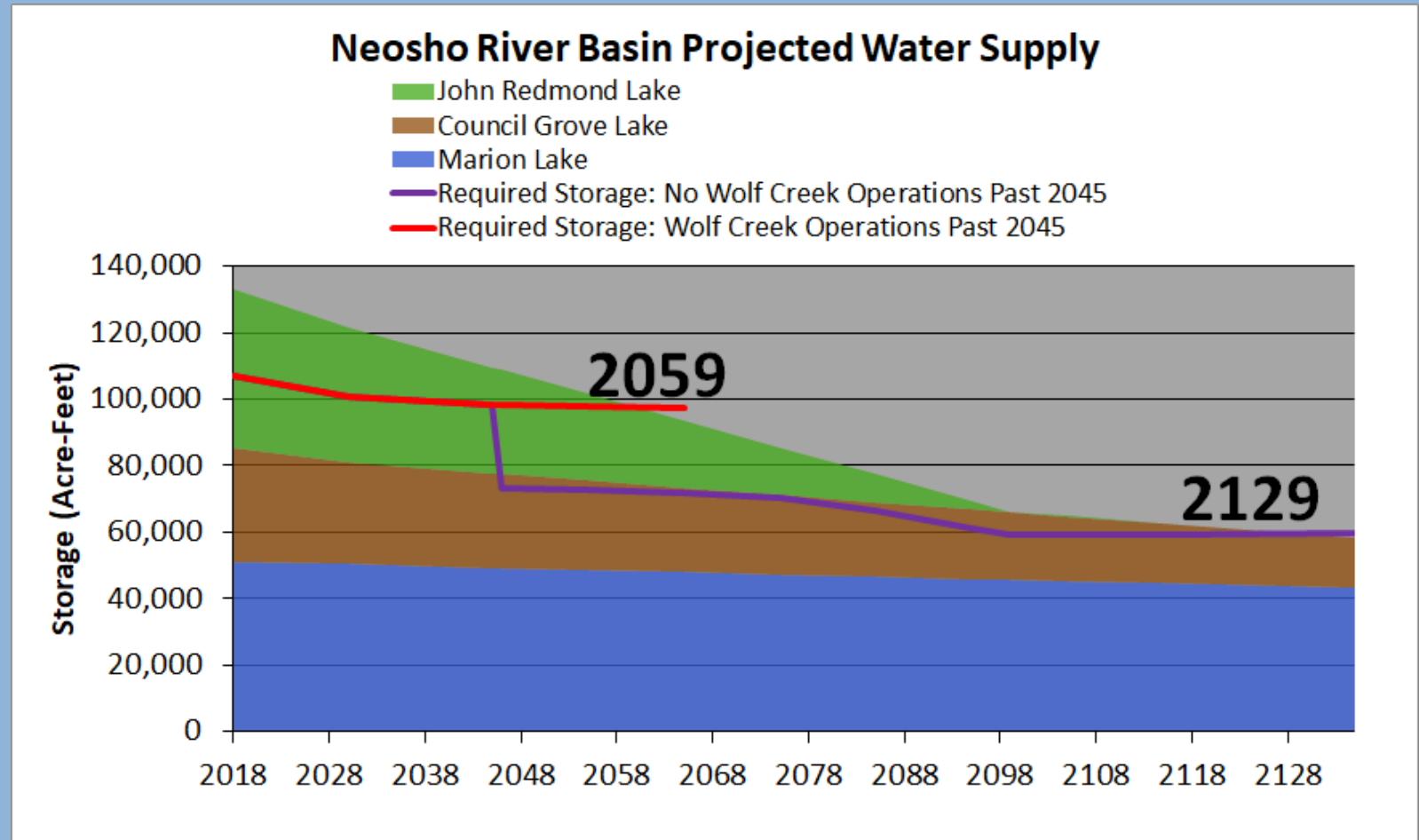
Water Use:

Priority Goal #1: Prolong the water supply storage in John Redmond Reservoir by stabilizing streambank hotspots and implementing soil health management principles and education on cropland.

Zebra Mussels have been found in all federal reservoirs within the region. KDWP continues to monitor and suppress zebra mussels and other AIS such as bighead carp within the Neosho River-Grand Lake system.



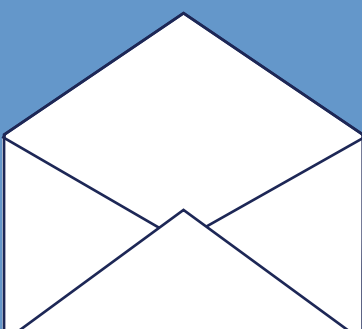
Marion Reservoir experienced HABs almost every year from first noted bloom in 2003.



Annual precipitation varies from 32 inches in the westernmost part of the region to almost 46 inches in the southeast. **This represents the area of the state with the most significant rainfall.**
