- I. Welcome and Roll Call: Jeffrey Porter (Local Government) called be meeting to order at 2:05 pm and welcomed the attendees to the meeting. Amelia Nill (KWO) called on each attendee for a brief introduction.
- **II. Regional Advisory Committee Approval of Agenda:** The agenda was approved as written.
- **III. Regional Advisory Committee (RAC) Approval of July 14th Meeting Notes:** A motion was made by Alan Albers (Agriculture) and seconded by Jeff Porter (Local Government) to accept the meeting notes as written. RAC members approved the meeting minutes with no further comments.

IV. RAC Business

- a. **RAC** member introductions: New and returning RAC members were given the opportunity to provide a brief introduction that included their professional background, where they live and what RAC category they represent.
- b. Great Plains Grassland Initiative: Dusty Tacha presented on the Great Plain Grassland Initiative. He

described the group's mission to address the woody encroachment problem in the state as well as the areas that the group currently operates. Dusty mentioned that the GPGI has worked with several landowners within the Gypsum Hills region to carry out prescribed burns.

- c. **Woody Encroachment & Prescribed Burn Presentation/Discussion:** Russell Blew gave the RAC an overview of the Gypsum Hills prescribed burn association, stating that it is a group of ranchers/landowners that pool resources together in order to carry out prescribed burns to manage the landscape. He stated that currently this group is trying to recruit more active members to participate in prescribed burns.
- **a. Budget review & updates:** Amelia Nill (KWO) updated the RAC members on the recently approved budget recommendations from the KWA. She highlighted particular line items that RAC members had questions on as well as reviewed the process that the budget will go through to be approved.
- d. **KWO/KWA Updates:** Amelia Nill (KWO) informed the RAC of the Legislative visits that will correspond with the January KWA meeting that will take place in Topeka on January 24th & 25th. She also stated that at the next RAC meeting, the group would review the roles and responsibilities of RAC members and the RAC as a whole.
- V. RAC Member Updates: Michael Coleman (Fish & Wildlife) informed the RAC of Ducks Unlimited efforts to install beaver dam analogs in portions of the state. Additionally, RAC members expressed interest in learning more about water quality and pollutants in the Red Hills Region.
- **VI.** Agency Comments:
 - a. Wade Kleven (KDHE) further highlighted the KDHE funding line items from the recommended budget.
