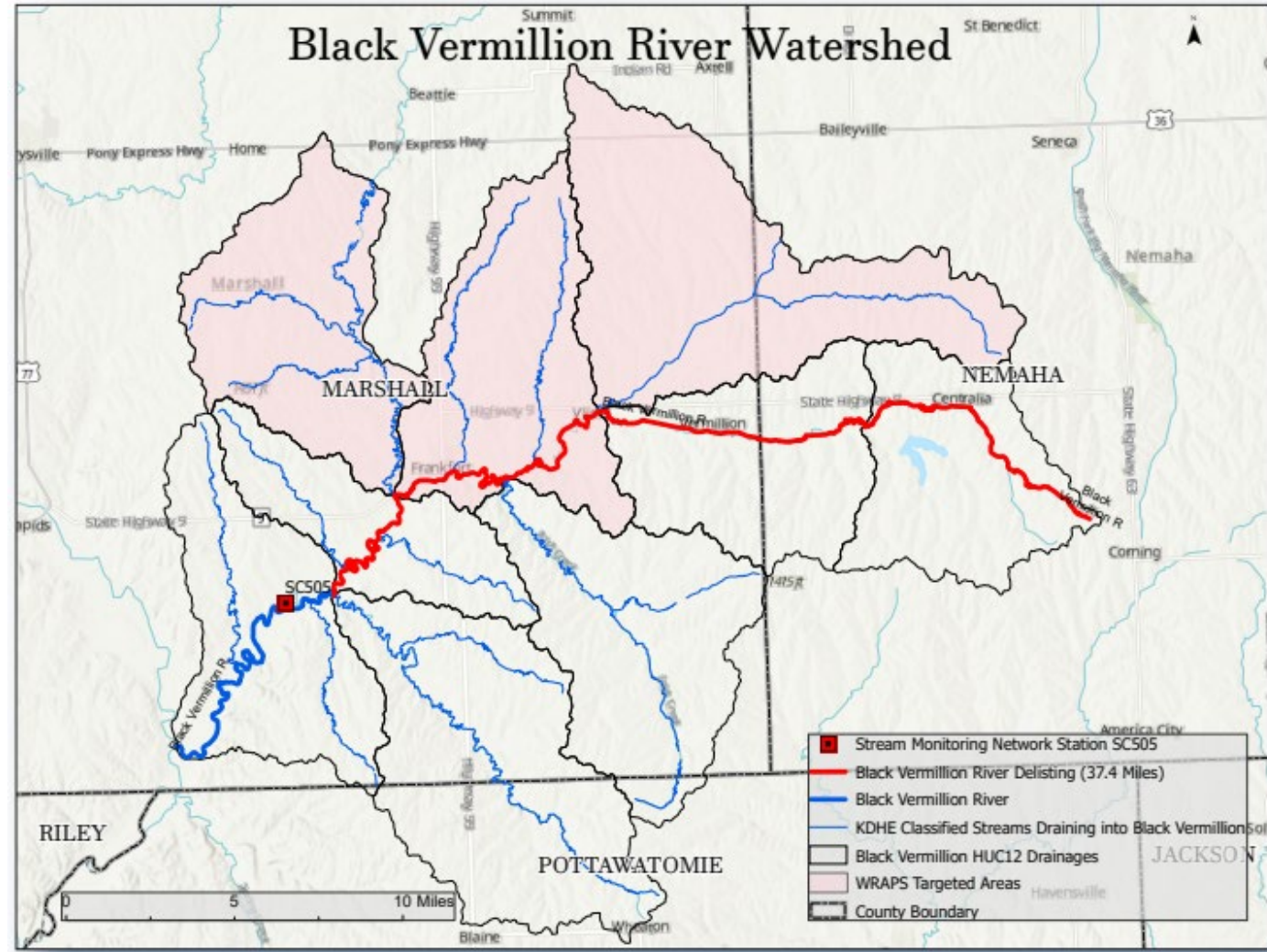
- Protect or restore the designated use of stream/lake

 - Program and Process

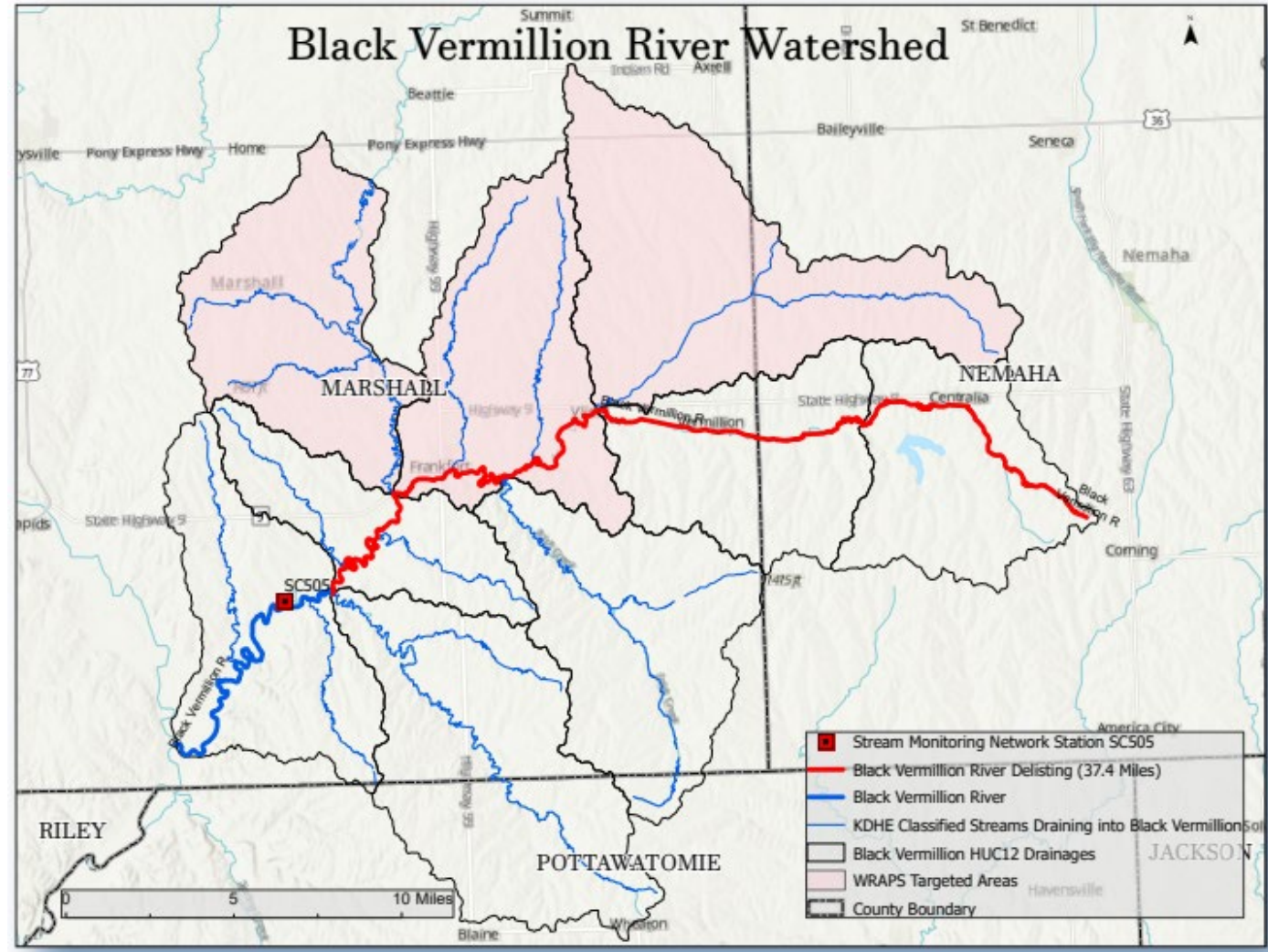
